### 1. What is Agile AI in a Box?

Agile AI in a Box is a virtual software team. You feed in a plain-English project brief, and it runs agile sprints—backlog, development, testing, iteration. I've validated the methodology by guiding AI to deliver two complex apps—without writing a single line of code.

### 2. Is there a working product today?

Not yet. The methodology is proven. Two apps are complete and serve as proof, but product packaging and user interface polish are still in progress.

### 3. Who's the target market?

Non-technical founders, solopreneurs, startups, and small businesses that can't afford full development teams. The global no-code AI platform market is projected to grow from ~\$3.8B–5B today to \$25–30B by 2030, with CAGRs ranging from 25–38% (Grand View Research, Markets & Markets).

### 4. What makes this different from other AI coding tools?

Other platforms give you just the code. Agile AI in a Box provides a complete virtual team—project management, iterative workflow, architecture, coding, and QA—without requiring you to be technical.

### 5. What's being offered to a partner?

- Up to 49% equity (vesting over time)

### 6. What's expected from a partner?

- To lead the go-to-market, operations, and scaling
- Provide modest funding support (~\$5–10K/month) to enable me to stay fully focused on product development

### 7. What does the founder bring to the table?
